West Michigan Rivers-Fishing Report

January 2nd, 2010

We have snow and steelhead

Pere Marquette Temps - mid 30's

Water Conditions - average

>>>So far it has been a good winter for fishing, decent snow levels with mild temps. The river is in good shape with the lower sections still open. Fishing is average to good considering water temps are only a few degrees above freezing. *Kevin Morlock*

Big Manistee Temps - 33

Water Conditions - a little above average

>>>Steelheading on the Big Manistee River is good. Drifting egg and nymph patterns and slow swinging streamers have both been winning choices.

Muskegon Temps - 34

Water Conditions - slight stain, average level

>>>Steelhead are in the deeper holding water. Bottom bounce for them with stones, wiggle hex's and black leaches. The boat launches are icy and snow packed... use caution!
