January 25th, 2010

Good Steelhead Fishing with Nice Winter Weather

**Pere Marquette** Temps - low 30's Water Conditions - average

>>>The lower PM River has had a good bite going, though the upper and middle sections have been more hit or miss. Possibly with this rain some of those lower river fish will head upstream a few miles. *Kevin Morlock*

**Big Manistee** Temps - 35 Water Conditions - high average

>>>Solid steelhead fishing on the Manistee River. Anglers are boating fish consistently on a variety of methods and enjoying the nice weather.

**Muskegon** Temps - 34 Water Conditions - average

>>>Look for the steelie bite to be at it's best during the afternoon when the water warms a degree or two. Fish on the bottom with stones, wiggle hexs and black leaches. The boat launches are slick. *Phil Cusey*
